**Pulpit Series in December: The Five Solas of the Reformation**

This year 2017 marks the 500th Anniversary of the start of the Reformation. The WATCH committee decides to have a pulpit series on the Five Solas, to coincide with the Advent season.

Martin Luther's starting point was Rom1:16,17 -- the Spirit-given revelation that God's righteousness ("justification") is received through faith alone, and this not of ourselves or our good works but gifted by God's grace alone. His faith was founded not on church traditions and the Bible but on Scripture alone (he later translated the Bible from Greek and Hebrew into German), which is of course to be focused in Christ alone, and for the glory of God alone.

The Reformation is considered to have begun with the 95 Theses (against indulgences and other abuses) which Luther posted on the door of the castle church of Wittenberg on 31 October 1517. This Reformation Faith sheds light on the true heart of the Gospel, and has a global impact.
