Pulpit Series: Journey to Glory—Lessons from Exodus

The exodus is the one main event that Israel is always called to recall when they try to relate to who God is, much like our salvation on the cross. Studying how God's hand moved the events that led to the exodus and His reasons/motivations for doing so reveal much about His character.

It brings an even greater revelation when we relate those same motivations to how He calls us into salvation and guides us back to the cross. Exodus is a call from slavery into worship, for the Jews, and even more so for his children.

Alpha Centralised Team Training (for both Alpha and Youth Alpha)

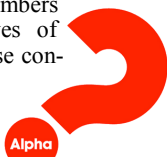
