Reconciliation

a) Between God and man

- We were once far off, with no hope and no God
- Christ paid the price for us to end the hostility and bring peace and reconciliation to us

b) Between Jew and Gentile

- Barrier between Jew and Gentile
- A new man, a new kingdom, a new family and a new temple

Implications and Applications

a) Reconciled to Others

- An "agent" of Reconciliation
- Practical steps to reconciliation

b) Reconciled to Self

- Our Past and Our Surrender

Remember

a) What pushes us on? What makes us continually amazed and humbled by the cross?

- 1) Have you experienced reconciliation with God? What does that mean to you? How does that make you feel?
- 2) Has reconciliation with God led to you seeking/maintaining reconciliation with others?
- 3) How do you see reconciliation and the gospel? Can others see you living this gospel?
