Jesus' last command in Matthew 28:18-20 was to go and make disciples of all nations. He did not ask the disciples to make church members but to make disciples—to make followers of Christ. This meant preaching the good news of the Kingdom, going into all of Judea and Samaria and to the remotest parts of the earth, teaching & building disciples up in the faith in order to reproduce it in others (i.e. to abide in Him, be enrolled into authentic communities of grace and love and to bear fruit in every good work.)

This is the Grand Pursuit! And the Grand Promise is that He will be with us always right to the end of time. Let us not lose sight of this and recommit to this our Grand Purpose as we begin 2015.

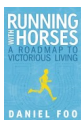
