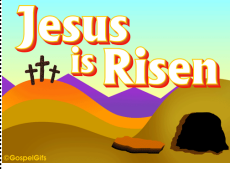

Last Week's Service... Ephesians 2:12-13 (ESV) “Remember that you were at that time separated from Christ, alienated from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers to the covenant of promise, having no hope and without God in the world. But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.

Ephesians 2:19 “So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God.”

Our Response: “Father, thank You that while we were dead in sin, Christ died for us, redeemed us by His blood, and made us alive, so that we are reconciled to You. Thank You also that in Christ, the distinction between Jews and Gentiles has been abolished, and all of us have access to You and can worship You on equal footing. Please help us to appreciate that we are all members of Your family: May we be led by the Spirit to strive to accept our brothers and sisters in Christ, and to be at peace with them. When relationships are strained, we pray for grace to take appropriate steps to clarify the situation, to listen, to forgive, and to let the hurt pass. Finally, we pray that the Spirit will empower us to be effective agents of reconciliation.
