The HIP is scheduled to run from mid June - end July (dates flexible).



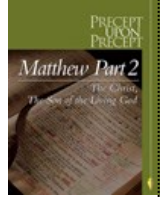

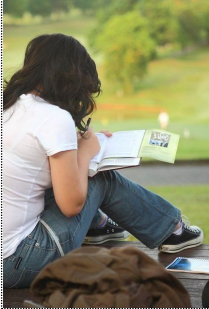
