Discussion Questions:

1. Do you consider persecution to be avoidable or unavoidable for Christians in Singapore? Why? What does today's Bible passage/message tell us?
2. Is witnessing for Jesus a privilege or a burden to you? What difference should it make, to know that Jesus has chosen us out of the world and to testify about him?
3. How does the Holy Spirit enable and empower us to witness for Jesus to the world?
4. In light of Jesus' forewarning of persecution, how should we prepare ourselves and spur each other in the meantime so as to be ready when it happens to us?

Pulpit Series on Gospel of John "Life In His Name"

"Who is Jesus?" No other question is of greater significance for us. John's Gospel tells us: Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God and by believing you may have life in his name (John 20:31). But what does it mean that Jesus is "the Christ"? How may we believe that, & what does it mean to "believe"? What does it mean to "have life"? And how must we respond? All this and more will be unpacked as we explore the riches of the 4th Gospel in our sermon series on John. Do pray for these brethren who will be taking us through the series.
