### QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION:

1. How would you define “the kingdom of God?”
2. What is the back story or the biblical narrative behind the idea of the kingdom of God and Jesus as the coming king? Do research on the kingdom of God from [gotquestions.org](https://www.gotquestions.org) <https://www.gotquestions.org/kingdom-of-God.html> and the Gospel Coalition website <https://www.thegospelcoalition.org/essay/the-kingdom-of-god/> on top of the verses shared during the sermon. (Genesis 1-3, Psalms 93; Isaiah 9, 53)
3. The Kingdom is already present and at the same time is still in the future. See verse Mark 1:14-15, Luke 17:20-21 (Kingdom is present) and Mark 14:25, Luke 19:11 (Kingdom is future). Is this a contradiction or what can it possibly mean?
4. What does Jesus mean when he says “But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness,” (Matthew 6:33) or when he tells his disciples “Pray then in this way, ..Your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven” (Matthew 6:10), or when he says “Blessed are those who have been persecuted for the sake of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven”? (Matthew 5:10)
5. How do we see Jesus? If we recognize Jesus as King, how would it affect the way we live? (See Christ’s manifesto on kingdom living and Kingdom Ethics in Matthew 5-7)
6. How does Christ’s crucifixion and resurrection define the idea of the kingdom of God? (Philippians 2:1-11; Ephesians 1)
7. Christ is going to return and consummate His kingdom (Revelation 19, Revelation 21 & 22). He is going to be the reigning King, over a redeemed people in the new heaven and earth. How does this truth and hope for the future impact us right now?
